WHEREAS, the Regional Emergency Dispatch Authority Executive Board, authorizes the scheduled holidays for all REDA employees;


NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED the following holidays be designated as scheduled, paid holidays for all REDA employees for the calendar year 2019:


No employee shall be paid for any authorized holiday if that employee is absent from a regularly scheduled shift immediately preceding or following such holiday unless the employee provides a written doctor's excuse for such an absence.

If a holiday falls on an employee's regular day off, those hours will be paid to the employee at regular time for that day. If a holiday falls on an employee's regularly scheduled workday, that employee shall receive regular rate of pay and holiday pay for those hours worked.
